The amendment referred to above is conditionally approved in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(B) since you have agreed in your letter dated April 25, 1995 to:

a. Address concerns pertaining to potential groundwater issues stipulated in our April 4, 1995 letter.

b. To submit production information (pounds or gallons produced) for this product for the fiscal year in which the use on tomatoes is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA Section 29. The fiscal year begins October 1 and ends September 30.

c. Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) or FIFRA section 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

Submit two (2) copies of your complete final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For any requirements specific to your State or Tribe, consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulation.

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS FOR USE AND PRECAUTIONS ON THIS LABEL MAY RESULT IN CROP INJURY AND/OR POOR INSECT CONTROL.

Trigard is a 75% wettable powder which, when mixed with water according to the directions for use given below, will control certain insect species on designated plants.

Mixing Instructions

Prepare no more spray mixture than is needed for the immediate operation. Thoroughly clean spray equipment before using this product. Agitate thoroughly before and during application. Good bypass agitation is sufficient to keep Trigard thoroughly mixed. Flush spray tank thoroughly with water daily after use and dispose of pesticide rinsate by application to an already treated area.

Trigard Alone: Add 2/3 of the required amount of water to the spray or mixing tank. With the agitator running, drop the required number of unopened soluble bags of Trigard into the tank. [One 2-lb, water-soluble bag of Trigard will treat 12 acres of

tomatoes. One 2.66-ounce, water-soluble packet (1/6 lb) will treat one acre of tomatoes.] Continue agitation while adding the remainder of the water.

Note: Do not let spray mixture stand overnight in the spray tank. Rinse spray tank at the end of the day.

To avoid spray drift, do not apply under windy conditions. Avoid spray overlap, as crop injury may result.

Aerial applications should be used only when conditions exist that prohibit application by ground equipment. Applications by ground equipment should be directed toward crop foliage.

Chemigation: Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

For leafminer control, apply 1/6 lb (one packet) of Trigard per acre as a foliar spray in a minimum of 50 gals. of water, by ground as leafminers first appear. Repeat applications at 7-day intervals or as necessary to maintain control.

Note. To avoid possible illegal residues, do not make more than 6 applications to one crop of tomatoes.

Rotational Crops

Any crop on the Trigard label may be planted following harvest of a Trigard-treated crop. Do not rotate to any other crop, except sweet corn or radishes. Do not plant sweet corn or radishes within 3 months after the last application.

Storage and Disposal

Store in a cool, dry place. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Do not use in animal feeds.

Storage

Do not store this product under wet conditions. Handle outer container carefully to avoid breakage of water-soluble packets.
