



A slight film will appear upon drying leaving residual killing power. This product may be used inside and outside the home for control of the pests specified on this label.

## INDOOR USE

#### Controls:

Cockroaches (waterbugs), ants, firebrats, silverfish, brown dog ticks, springtails, spiders, crickets, earwigs, sowbugs (pillbugs), carpet beetles.
