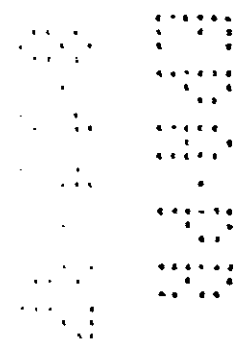

General Information

Apron T69 is a prepackaged combination of 45% metalaxyl and 24% thiabendazole. This combination provides a unique blend of systemic and protectant activity. Metalaxyl provides control of systemic downy mildew (Peronospera pisi), and control of the soil borne diseases caused by Pythium spp. Thiabendazole controls the diseases caused by the Ascochyta complex, i.e., leaf and pod spot caused by Ascochyta pisi; blight caused by Mycosphaerella pinodes; and foot rot caused by Phoma medicaginis var. pinodella.

Note: Apron is a systemic fungicide having a specific mode of action. Apron could be subject to development of resistant strains of fungi. Development of resistance cannot be predicted. Therefore, CIBA-GEIGY cannot assume liability for crop damage resulting from resistant strains of fungi.

Apply Apron T69 in 8 fl. oz. of water per 100 lbs. of seed as a slurry through standard slurry or mist-type commercial seed treatment equipment.

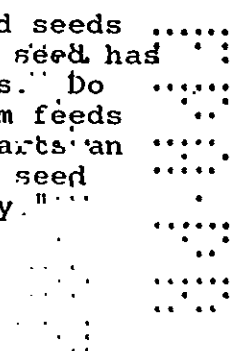

Seed Peas

For control of Pythium seed rot and damping off, downy mildew and the Ascochyta-complex: Apply Apron T69 as a seed treatment at the rate of 2 1/2 oz. per 100 lbs. of seed.

Note: Federal law requires that bags containing treated seeds shall be labeled with the following information: "This seed has been treated with metalaxyl and thiabendazole fungicides. Do not use for feed, food or oil purposes. Store away from feeds and foodstuffs." Use with an EPA-approved dye that imparts an unnatural color to the seed. All containers of treated seed must contain the statement "Treated seed for export only."



Storage and Disposal

Pesticide Storage and Disposal

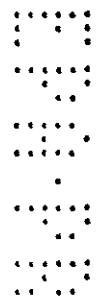
Store in a dry place. Do not store near heat or open flame. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal, or cleaning of equipment. Open dumping is prohibited.
