General Information

Pace Turf Fungicide, a fungicide that has both systemic and contact properties, controls Pythium blight and yellow tuft (downy mildew) in turfgrasses, and downy mildew in St. Augustinegrass. When used in a preventative program to control Pythium blight and yellow tuft, Pace will also provide control of brown patch, dollar spot and Helminthosporium-type diseases.

Research has shown that the ingredients in Pace Note: can provide synergistic activity against Pythium blight. In addition research has demonstrated that when properly managed, the use of fungicides with different sites of action reduces the likelihood of resistance developing. As with many turf fungicides, however, the use of Pace could result in development of resistant strains of fungi. If resistance does develop, CIBA-GEIGY cannot assume liability for resulting turf damage. If treat If treatment is not effective following the use of Pace as recommended, a resistant strain of fungi may be present or the disease may have been misdiaqnosed. Consideration should then be given to the prompt use of other types of suitable fungicides. Consult with your State Agricultural Experiment Station or Extension Service Specialist for guidance in your particular crop and disease control situation.

<u>Re-entry and Worker Protection Statements</u>

IMPORTANT NOTE REGARDING USE ON GOLF COURSES: THE FOLLOWING REENTRY STATEMENT APPLIES TO ALL USES OF PACE ON NONRESIDENTIAL TURF, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF GOLF COURSES. WHERE PACE IS USED TO TREAT TURF ON A GOLF COURSE, THE 24-HOUR REENTRY RESTRICTION DOES NOT APPLY. HOWEVER, SPRAYS MUST BE DRY BEFORE GOLFERS CAN ENTER THE TREATED AREA. GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE PERSONNEL MUST WEAR THE PERSONAL PROTECTIVE FOUIPMENT LISTED BELOW UNDER WORKFR PROTECTION WHEN MIXING, LOADING, APPLYING, OR REENTERING THE AREA BEFORE SPRAYS HAVE DRIED.

REENTRY

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Do not enter treated areas without protective clothing until sprays have dried. After sprays have dried, do not enter or allow entry into treated areas until the 24-hour re-entry interval has expired unless wearing the personal protective equipment listed on this label. (See <u>IMPORTANT NOTE</u> above regarding use on golf courses.) Because certain states may require more restrictive re-entry intervals for various crops treated with this product, consult your State Department of Agriculture for further information. Do not apply this product in such a manner as to directly or through drift expose workers or other persons. The area being treated must be vacated by unprotected persons.

Written or oral warnings must be given to workers who are expected to be in a treated area or in an area about to be treated with this product. Oral warnings must include the same information that is in the written warnings.

WORKER PROTECTION

<u>WORKER SAFETY RULES</u>: Keep all unprotected persons, children, livestock and pets away from treated area cr where there is danger of drift. Do not rub eyes or mouth with hands. (See <u>Statement of Practical Treatment.</u>)

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT: For Mixers, Loaders, Applicators, and Early Re-entry Workers.

HANDLE THIS PRODUCT ONLY WHEN WEARING THE FOLLOWING PROTECTIVE CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT: a long-sleeved shirt and long pants or a coverall that covers all parts of the body except the head, hands, and feet, chemical-resistant gloves and footgear, socks,

*Mowers do not have to wear goggles or a face shield when entering the treated area before sprays have dried.

During application from a tractor with a completely enclosed cab with positive pressure filtration, or aerially with an enclosed cockpit, a long-sleeved shirt and long pants may be worn in place of the above protective clothing. Chemical-resistant gloves must be available in the cab or cockpit and worn while exiting.

<u>IMPORTANT</u>! Before removing gloves, wash them with soap and water. Always wash hands, face and arms with soap and water before eating, smoking or drinking. Always wash hands and arms with soap and water before using the toilet.

After work take off all clothes and shoes. Shower using soap and water. Wear only clean clothes. Do not use contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and protective equipment with soap and water after each use. Personal clothing worn during use must be laundered separately from household a: les. Clothing and protective equipment heavily contaminated or drenched with mancozeb must be destroyed according to state and local regulations.

HEAVILY CONTAMINATED OR DRENCHED CLOTHING CANNOT BE ADEQUATELY DECONTAMINATED.

During aerial application, human flaggers are prohibited unless in totally enclosed vehicles.

Mixing Instructions

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Prepare no more spray mixture than is required for the immediate operation. Thoroughly clean spray equipment before using this product. Agitate thoroughly before and during application. Good bypass agitation is sufficient to keep Pace thoroughly mixed and in suspension. Flush spray tank thoroughly with water daily after use and dispose of pesticide rinsate by application to an already treated area.

<u>Notes</u>: (1) Soluble bags of Pace must be dissolved completely in water before any other tank mix partner, including micronutrients or other liquid or dry fertilizers are added to the spray solution. (3) Do not use with oils or adjuvants.

<u>Pace Alone</u>: Add 2/3 of the required amount of water to the spray or mixing tank. With the agitator running, drop the required number of unopened soluble bags of Pace into the tank. (One 2-lb. water-soluble bag of Pace will treat 5,000 sq. ft.) Continue agitation while adding the remainder of the water. <u>Pace + Tank Mixtures</u>: For tank mix purposes, Pace is usually compatible with Banner®, Triumph®, Sprint®, Bayleton®, Daconil 2787®, $D \cdot z \cdot n$ ®, Fore®, Tersan LSR®, Tersan 1991® and VorlanTM. Add 2/3 of the required amount of water to the spray or mixing tank. With the agitator running, drop the required number of <u>unopened</u> soluble bags of Pace into the tank. Then add the desired amount of the selected tank mix partner(s) which are registered for use on turf.

If using Pace in a tank mixture, observe all directions for use, crops/sites, use rates, dilution ratios, precautions, and limitations which appear on the respective tank mix product label. No label dosage rate should be exceeded and the more restrictive of the labels regarding precautions and limitations should be followed. This product cannot be mixed with any product containing a label prohibition against such mixing.

Application Instructions

<u>Note</u>: Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

Do not make applications when weather conditions favor drift from target area. Avoid spray overlap as turf injury may result.

<u>Turf</u> (Non-Residential Coly)

<u>Pythium blight and yellow tuft</u>: Apply Pace as a preventative treatment using one 2 lb. bag to treat 5,000 sq. ft. in 6-10 gals. of water. During periods favorable for disease development, retreat at 7-14 day intervals. For maintenance treatments during periods of cooler weather, treatments can be extended to 21 days.

Under low to moderate disease pressure, Pace applied as a preventative treatment on a 7-14 day interval will provide control of brown patch, dollar spot and Helminthosporium-type pathogens.

Notes: (1) Do not graze treated areas. (2) Do not feed clippings to livestock. (3) Do not plant any crop which is not registered for use with metalaxyl in metalaxyl-treated soil for a period of 12 months.

Storage and Disposal

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Storage - Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store this product under wet conditions.

<u>Pesticide Disposal</u> - Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal, or cleaning of equipment. Open dumping is prohibited. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on-site or at an approved waste disposal facility. <u>Container Disposal</u> - Do not reuse outer carton. Dispose of empty outer carton in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or by open burning, if allowed by state and local authorities. If burned, keep out of smoke.

For minor spills, etc., follow all precautions indicated on this label and clean up immediately. Take special care to avoid contamination of equipment and facilities during cleanup procedures and disposal of wastes.
