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**Transplanted Tomatoes - Dual II Alone**

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Dual II may be applied preplant incorporated or preplant before transplanting. If the latter method is used, keep soil disturbance to a minimum during the transplanting operation to prevent weed emergence from untreated soil. Or application may be made post-directed or post-over-the-top of transplants after the first settling rain or irrigation. When an application is made post-directed or post-over-the-top, apply in a minimum of 20 gals. of water/A. Dual II will not control emerged weeds. Follow instructions for use of Dual II alone under **Application Procedures**. On coarse soils, apply 1.5-2.0 pts./A of Dual II if organic matter content is less than 3%, or 2 pts./A if organic matter is 3% or greater. On medium soils, apply 2-2.5 pts./A of Dual II. On fine soils, apply 2-2.5 pts./A of Dual II if organic matter content is less than 3%, or 2.5-3.0 pts./A if organic matter content is 3% or greater.

Precautions: (1) For varieties or cultivars with unknown tolerance to Dual II, treat only a small area to determine if Dual II can be safely used. (2) Dual II may damage transplants that have been weakened by any cause. To prevent damage, plant only healthy transplants. Do not plant when wet, cool, or unfavorable growing conditions exist.

**Note:** To avoid possible illegal residues, (1) do not apply Dual II within 90 days of tomato harvest and (2) do not exceed the maximum labeled rate for the soil texture.
