General Information

Pace Fungicide, a fungicide that has both systemic and contact properties, controls Pythium blight and yellow tuft (downy mildew) in turfgrasses, and downy mildew in St. Augustinegrass. When used in a preventative program to control Pythium blight and yellow tuft, Pace will also provide control of brown patch, dollar spot and Helminthosporium-type diseases.

If this product is used on turf, no other product containing a different EBDC active ingredient may be used on the same turf during the same growing season.

Research has shown that the ingredients in Pace can provide synergistic activity against Pythium blight. In addition research has demonstrated that when properly managed, the use of fungicides with different sites of action reduces the likelihood of resistance developing. As with many turf fungicides, however, the use of Pace could result in development of resistant strains of fungi. If resistance does develop, CIBA-GEIGY cannot assume liability for resulting turf damage. ment is not effective following the use of Pace as recommended, a resistant strain of fungi may be present or the disease may have been misdiagnosed. Consideration should then be given to the prompt use of other types of suitable fungicides. Mixing Instructions

Prepare no more spray mixture than is required for the immediate operation. Thoroughly clean spray equipment before using this product. Agitate thoroughly before and during application. Good bypass agitation is sufficient to keep Pace thoroughly mixed and in suspension. Flush spray tank thoroughly with water daily after use and dispose of pesticide rinsate by application to an already treated area.

Notes: (1) Scluble bags of Pace must be dissolved completely in water before any other tank mix partner, including micronutrients or other liquid or dry fertilizers are added to the spray solution. (3) Do not use with oils or adjuvants.

<u>Pace Alone</u>: Add 2/3 of the required amount of water to the spray or mixing tank. With the agitator running, drop the required number of <u>unopened</u> soluble bags of Pace into the tank. (One 2-lb. water-soluble bag of Pace will treat 5,000 sq. ft.) Continue agitation while adding the remainder of the water.

Pace + Tank Mixtures: For tank mix purposes, Pace is usually compatible with Banner®, Triumph®, Sprint®, Bayleton®, Daconil 2787®, D·z·n®, Fore®, Tersan LSR®, Tersan 1991® and Vorlan™. Add 2/3 of the required amount of water to the spray or mixing tank. With the agitator running, drop the required number of unopened soluble bags of Pace into the tank. Then add the desired amount of the selected tank mix partner(s) which are registered for use on turf.

If using Pace in a tank mixture, observe all directions for use, crops/sites, use rates, dilution ratios, precautions, and limitations which appear on the respective tank mix product label. No label dosage rate should be exceeded and the more restrictive of the labels regarding precautions and limitations should be followed. This product cannot be mixed with any product containing a label prohibition against such mixing. Tank mixtures are permitted only in those states where the tank mix partner is registered.

Application Instructions

Note: Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

Do not make applications when weather conditions favor drift from target area. Avoid spray overlap as turf injury may result.

Turf

For use on golf courses, sod farms, industrial or municipal turf areas and professional application to residential lawns. NOT FOR USE BY HOMEOWNERS.



Pythium blight and yellow tuft: Apply Pace as a preventative treatment using one 2 lb. bag to treat 5,000 sq. ft. in 6-10 gals. of water. During periods favorable for disease development, retreat at 7-14 day intervals. For maintenance treatments during periods of cooler weather, treatments can be extended to 21 days.

Under low to moderate disease pressure, Pace applied as a preventative treatment on a 7-14 day interval will provide control of brown patch, dollar spot and Helminthosporium-type pathogens.

Notes: (1) Do not graze treated areas. (2) Do not feed clippings to livestock. (3) Do not use on grasses intended for grazing, such as range or pasture grasses. (4) Do not use for grasses grown for seed. (5) Do not plant any crop which is not registered for use with metalaxyl in metalaxyl-treated soil for a period of 12 months.

Storage and Disposal

<u>Storage</u> - Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store this product under wet conditions.
