2. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 100-760" to the label prior to releasing the product for shipment.
3. The basic and the alternate formulations dated February 14, 1994 are both acceptable and have been included in the record for this pesticide product.
4. Delete the label claim "...is not affected by sunlight so it keeps working in areas exposed to the sun."
5. The active ingredient statement footnote for *piperonyl butoxide* should declare the word "ether", and not the word "ester".
6. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

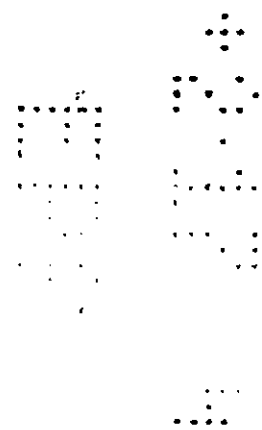
