The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable, provided you make the following changes before you release the product for shipment.

1. Change the order of Precautionary Statements to match the order of First Aid statements. Both should be ordered so that the most severe routes of exposure are listed first.
2. Under STORAGE AND DISPOSAL, change the subheading "Storage" to "Pesticide Storage."
3. Under STORAGE AND DISPOSAL, move the phrase "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal" to directly following the heading STORAGE AND DISPOSAL, and before Pesticide Storage.
4. It is recommended that you include Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) information on label for good product stewardship.

Submit three (3) copies of final printed labeling incorporating the above changes before you release the product for shipment. Amended labeling will supercede all previously accepted ones. A stamped copy of labeling is enclosed for your records.
