On page 6 of the Booklet label, under the "Note" section, delete the last sentence since the label and CSF indicates that the product already contains a dye.

General Information

Dividend 0.15 FS is a systemic seed dressing which controls or suppresses certain seed-borne and soil-borne diseases of wheat. An EPA-approved coloring agent. Pigment Red 48, has been added to the formulation.

Mixing Procedures

Dividend 0.15 FS is especially formulated for on-farm treatment using standard mechanical slurry or mist type seed treatment equipment which accurately meters and mixes a flowable seed treatment. The equipment must provide uniform coverage of Dividend 0.15 FS on the seed. Uneven seed coverage may not give the desired level of disease control. This product does not require the addition of water for application. Consult the manufacturer of the application equipment you plan to use for suitability for this application and for instructions on operation and calibration of the equipment.

Wheat

Apply Dividend 0.15 FS to wheat seed at the rates given in the following table for control of common bunt (seed-borne and soil-borne), dwarf bunt, loose smut, flag smut, general seed rots, and seed-borne Septoria; and for partial control of common root rot.

For control of damping-off of wheat caused by *Pythium* spp. the recommended rate of Dividend 0.15 FS may be tank mixed with Apron® flowable or wettable powder seed treatment products in accordance with the most restrictive label limitations and precautions. No labeled dosage rates should be exceeded. Use the Apron product at a rate of 0.032 oz. active ingredient per 100 lbs. of seed (2 g active ingredient/100 kg of seed) tank mixed with the recommended rates of Dividend 0.15 FS. Follow application and other instructions found on the Apron product label.

Partial control can either mean erratic control from good to poor or consistent control at a level below that generally considered acceptable for commercial disease control. For human Bunt, Dividend consistently reduces the germination of seed-borne teliosperes that construction as initial important: (1) Do not use treated seed for feed, food, or oil. (2) Green forage may not be grazed until 55 days after planting. (3) Do not plant any crop other than wheat within 30 days to fields in which treated seeds were planted.
