Birds, especially waterfowl (ducks or geese) feeding or drinking on treated areas may be killed. To reduce risks to birds:

- A. Do not treat areas larger than 15,000 sq. ft.
- B. Because of the migratory habits of certain waterfowl, do not apply in Nassau County, New York between November 1 and May 20.
