
If your pet brings new fleas into the treated areas, they can be killed by re-treating.

Fleas and Ticks

Apply as a spot treatment to areas pets may contact, such as floors, rugs, draperies, upholstery, pet bedding, cracks and crevices of walls and floors, baseboards, and window and door frames. This product will not stain most fabric or rugs, but test the product on a small inconspicuous area first before applying the product to fabric, rugs, or plastics. Pet bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas.

Also controls ants, carpet beetles, clover mites, cockroaches, crickets, earwigs, firebrats, flies, mosquitoes, silverfish, and spiders.

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame. Do not store below 32°F.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
