A. Use the EPA Registration Number 100-811.

B. Revise chemical name in ingredient statement to "Cyprodinil: 4-cyclopropyl-6-methyl-N-phenyl-pyrimidinamine" to match the nomenclature used by PMRA and information contained in the Federal Register Notice.

C. Add to the "If Inhaled" statement of practical treatment "If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention."

D. Since this product is in acute toxicity category III for eye irritation, precautionary statements must include "Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes." Statements of practical treatment must include "If in eyes: flush with water for 15 minutes and get medical attention if irritation persists."

E. The "If on Skin" statement of practical treatment must be revised to read "Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention."

F. The "Note to Physician" is not required, but may be retained if desired.

G. In the container disposal paragraph, reference to "application equipment" is not appropriate since this is a not an end-use product. Revise accordingly.

H. This product is considered a dermal sensitizer. Add the statement "Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals."

4. Submit one (1) copy of the final printed labeling for the record before you release the product for shipment.

5. Submit production information (pounds or gallons produced) for this product for the fiscal year in which the technical is conditionally registered, in accordance with FIFRA sec. 29. The fiscal year begins October 1, and ends September 20. The production information must be submitted to the Agency no later than November 15, following the end of the preceding fiscal year.
