Dear Ms. Strader:

The label amendment associated with the recently established S-metolachlor tolerances for cilantro and garden beet leaves submitted as part of an IR-4 action, and in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended is acceptable.

Per your request, the proposed supplemental label for 100-816, which includes Directions for Use on cilantro and garden beet leaves, was <u>not</u> reviewed as part of this action. The only stamped product label accompanying this decision is for 100-815.

Products released for shipment after 18 months from the date on this notice or the next printing of the label, whichever occurs first, must bear the new label language. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA. Per 40 CFR 156.10(6), you must submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Your release for shipment of this product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. One copy of the stamped label is attached for your records.
