with a Supplemental Label for Application of Barricade®  
65WG To Turfgrass before It Is Overseeded with  
Perennial Ryegrass, for Use in Alabama, Louisiana,  
Georgia, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina  
and Tennessee

The subject application to revise the labeling of Barricade® 65WG Herbicide by adding supplemental labeling for application to turf grass before it is over seeded with ryegrass only in Alabama, Louisiana, Georgia, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina and Tennessee has been reviewed and found to be acceptable under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, provided that you:

1. Submit a master label of the subject pesticide product registration that includes all use-patterns that have been accepted for this product and which reflects the labeling amendments to comply with PR Notices 2001-1 and 2001-6 within one year from the date of this letter, to assure compliance with PR Notice 2001-1. Also, revise the use of "Waterproof gloves" to read: "Chemical resistant gloves, such as barrier laminate, butyl rubber ≥ 14 mils, Polyvinyl chloride (PVC) ≥ 14 mils, or vitron ≥ 14 mils," where it is indicated on the present labeling.
2. Submit one (1) copy of the final printed label prior to your shipment of this pesticide product under the enclosed revised stamped label.


If these conditions are not complied with, the registration
