#### Dear Ms Rezaaiyan:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided the following changes are made:

- 1. Reinstate the First Aid Statements for, "If in eyes." Please note that the First Aid Statements for all routes of exposure have been revised. See PR Notice 2001-1 for these statements and compliance date of October 1, 2003, for making these revisions.
- 2. Revise the glove statement in the precautionary section from, rubber gloves" to "chemical resistant gloves."

The label for the alternate brand name Thiabendazole MF has not been reviewed. All precautionary statements, restriction, limitation and ingredient statement for this label must be identical to the master label, Thiabendazole RC. The alternate brand name was approved through the notification process on January 31, 2001 and copy of this label is in the file for this product.

The revised basic confidential statement of formulation (CSF) dated March 1, 2001 is acceptable. This CSF supercedes all other previously accepted basic formulations. A copy of this CSF has been placed in the file for this product.

Please submit one (1) copy of your final printed label before releasing the product for shipment. If the conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subjected to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA Section 6 (e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitute acceptance of these conditions.
