The application referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, to add new seed treatment uses on alfalfa; vegetable root (except sugarbeet), subgroup 1B; onion, bulb, subgroup 3-07A; brassica, head and stem, subgroup 5-A; vegetable, cucurbit group 9, spinach (including baby); and small grain cereals (wheat, barley, oats, rye, and triticale), is acceptable under FIFRA Section 3(c)(7)(B), subject to the following conditions:

1. You must submit and/or cite all data required for registration/registration/registration review of your product under FIFRA when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling.
