The amended labeling referred to above submitted under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as amended to revise the Signal Word from Warning to Caution and revise other precautionary language based on new toxicological data is acceptable provided you make the following changes

- 1 Pg 2 Reorder the First Aid statements to
 - a If on skin or clothing
 - b If swallowed
 - c If in eyes
- 2 Revise the Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals Statement to read Harmful if absorbed through skin Harmful if swallowed Avoid contact with skin eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating drinking chewing gum using tobacco or using the toilet. Wear long sleeved shirt and long pants, socks, shoes, and chemical resistant gloves made of any waterproof material. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.
