The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. The acute oral toxicity study (MRID No. 44343801) remains classified as Toxicity Category I for oral. Consequently, the signal word must remain as DANGER.

With respect to the confidential statement of formula (CSF), the Agency has reviewed the revised basic CSF dated October 15, 2002. The submitted revised basic CSF is acceptable and a copy has been placed in the product file. This revised basic CSF replaces all previous basic CSFs for the subject product.


