



Plastic Containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent); then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or alternatives allowed by State and local authorities.

Glass Containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent), then dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other approved state and local procedures.
