 - i. Freshwater invertebrate acute toxicity (850.1010)
 - ii. Freshwater fish acute toxicity (850.1075)
 - iii. Estuarine/marine fish acute toxicity (850.1025)
 - iv. Estuarine/marine fish early life-stage toxicity (850.1400)
 - v. Avian acute oral toxicity (850.2100)
