
1. Under the heading Caution, replace "...goggles, rubber gloves..." with the following:

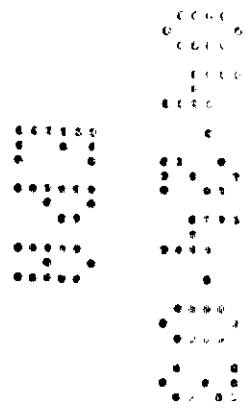

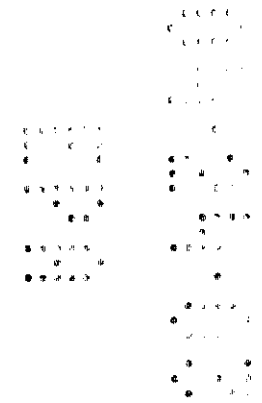

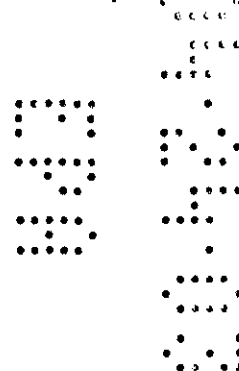
