**IF INHALED:** Remove to fresh air. Seek medical attention if respiratory irritation occurs or breathing becomes difficult.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Do not store near seeds and fertilizer. Keep container closed when not in use. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.
