- 1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. For Reward Manufacturing Concentrate, EPA Registration No. 100-1063, update the Hazards to Humans section to read as follows:

Harmful if inhaled. Harmful if swallowed. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid breathing spray mist. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chew gum or using tobacco. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wear protective eyewear. Wear long sleeve shirt and long pants, socks shoes and gloves.

b. For Regione Desiccant, EPA Registration No. 100-1061, and Reward Landscape and Aquatic Herbicide, EPA Registration No. 100-1091, update the Hazards to Humans section to read as follows:

Harmful if inhaled. Harmful if swallowed. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing.
