Dear Ms. Brinkley:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below.

- 1. Under the Precautionary Statements, add the following statements: "Wear protective clothing and gloves (Coveralls worn over short-sleeve shirt and short pants, socks, chemical resistant-footwear and waterproof gloves). Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, and using tobacco". Revise the statement "Causes eye irritation" to read "Causes moderate eye irritation." Delete the statement "Wash thoroughly after handling."

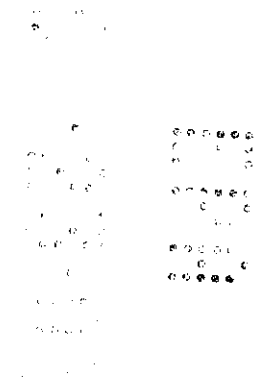
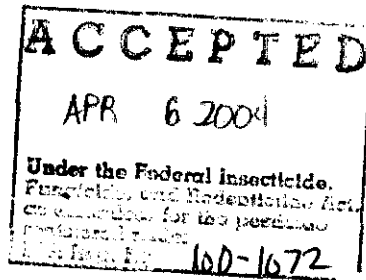

Administer atropine sulfate, either by intramuscular or intravenous injection, dependant on severity of poisoning. Since there is no therapeutic effect, the use of oximes (e.g., 2-PAM) or other cholinesterase reactivators is contraindicated. <u>Avoid the use of respiratory depressants, e.g. barbiturates and opiates.</u></p> <p>Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.</p>

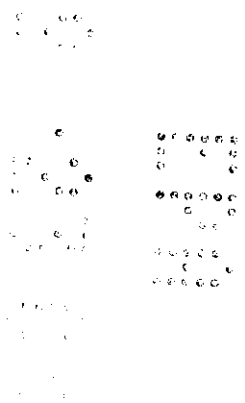

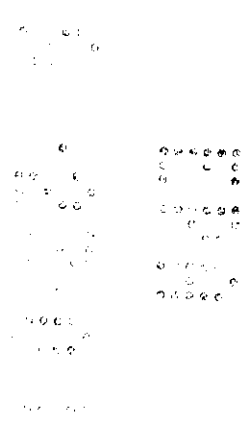
