FIRST AID	
If swallowed	 Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention.
If on skin	Wash with plenty of soap and water.
If in eyes	Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
If inhaled	Remove to fresh air. Get medical attention.

Note to Physician or Veterinarian

This product may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause hemorrhaging. If poisoning occurs, intramuscular and oral administration of Vitamin K_1 are indicated, as in poisoning from overdose of bishydroxy coumarin. For human cases, Vitamin K_1 is antidotal at doses of 10-20 mg (not mg/kg). For animal cases, Vitamin K_1 is antidotal at 2-5 mg/kg. Repeated doses may need to be given up to two weeks (based on monitoring of prothrombin times). In severe cases, blood transfusions may be necessary.
