Therefore, add the following paragraph that currently appears on the EUP label under the heading "Termite Protection" on page 6 of the booklet:

"To provide protection against the most common entry points of subterranean termites, it is necessary to effectively secure the perimeter of the building. When using the IMPASSE Barrier after the final grading has been done around the structure, a treatment may be applied to the perimeter of the structure using an EPA-registered approved termiticide."

Please submit two (2) copies of your final printed label for before your release the product for shipment. Please refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
