b. Independently validated analytical chemistry methods to identify and quantify residues in water. These methods must be sufficiently sensitive to adequately determine NOAEC, EC05, and characterize residues in water resources.

c. A repeat of the Tier II aquatic vascular plant test on *Lemma gibba* with the technical in the acidic pH range.

d. A repeat of the Tier II aquatic plant test on the blue-green algae *Anabaena flos-algae* with the technical.

2. If necessary, you will submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

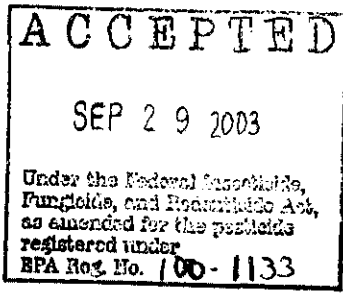
