Dear Ms. Dinnen:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, provided you make the following changes:

1. On page 3, change the sentence to read "The Directions for Use of this product **must** be followed carefully."
2. On page 3, add the phrase "**To the extent consistent with applicable law**" directly in front of the following warranty and liability statements:  
"All such risks shall be assumed by Buyer and User, and Buyer..."  
"SYNGENTA MAKES NO WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY..."  
"In no event shall SYNGENTA or Seller be liable for any incidental..."  
"THE EXCLUSIVE REMEDY OF THE USER OR BUYER..."
