DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Touchdown Ready To Use is a nonselective foliar systemic herbicide used to control a broad spectrum of emerged grass and broadleaf weeds, both annual and perennial, **down to the roots**. Any product not absorbed by plants breaks down into natural materials without moving in or on the soil to untreated plants. Touchdown Ready To Use may be used in the following areas:

- Along fences
- Flowerbeds
- Patios and driveways





- Around shrubs and trees
- Vegetable gardens
- Walkways

Important Note:

- Damage may be caused by contact with any vegetation to which treatment is not intended.
- Rainproof: rainfall or watering 2 hours after application will not reduce weed control.
- Do not spray if conditions for drift onto adjacent desirable plants exist.
- All ornamental flowers, trees, and shrubs may be planted 1 day after application.
- Touchdown Ready To Use will only control emerged weeds and has no soil activity; apply when weeds are actively growing.
- Not recommended for spot treatment in lawns because this product will injure or kill any grass intercepting the spray.
- People and pets may re-enter treated areas immediately after spray has dried.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage

Use and store this product in its original container. Store product in a secure storage area. Protect from freezing.

Container Disposal

Do not use container for any use other than as described on this label. Partially filled or empty container may be disposed of by wrapping in several layers of newspaper and discarding in trash. In case of a spill or leak, soak up with absorbent paper towels and discard in trash. Container is not safe for food, feed, or drinking water.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- Use a coarse spray and apply until wet to weeds to be controlled.
- For best results, apply to actively growing weeds when air temperature :s above 60°F.
- When spot spraying, use a cardboard or plastic shield to protect desirable plants from being sprayed. If desirable plants are accidentally sprayed, rinse them off immediately with ample water.
- If needed, make repeat treatments to established weeds approximately 2 weeks after initial application.

 Sprayed weeds usually begin to wilt within hours after application with complete kill in 1-2 weeks.
