- b. For consistency with the CSFs revise the active ingredient statement to read "glyphosate, N-(phosphonomethyl)glycine, in the form of the monopotassium salt.
- c. Modify the footnote to the active ingredient statement to give the number of pounds per US gallon of glyphosate acid equivalents.
