

- On the home lawn
- In landscaped areas around the home

How This Product Works

This product is a granular bait that attracts fire ants. By acting slowly it allows worker ants time to pick up the bait and take it back to the fire ant mound. The worker ants feed the bait to other ants throughout the colony and eventually to the queen. Worker ants eventually die, the queen stops producing eggs, and the fire ant colony is eliminated.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

When to Apply

For best results:

- Apply when ants are actively foraging (typically when soil temperatures are greater than 60°F).
- Apply after dew or rainfall has dried.
- Do not apply if rainfall is anticipated within 4-6 hours after application.

NOTE:

- Wait 7-10 days after applying this product before using an insecticide that kills fire ants on contact. Worker ants must be alive and have time to pick up this product, travel to the mound, and distribute this product throughout the colony.
- If very large mounds remain active or if fire ants re-infest the treated area, wait 3-4 months after the first application and retreat.

How to Apply

METHOD	AMOUNT	DIRECTIONS
Individual Mound Treatment	5-7 tablespoons per mound	When fire ants are actively foraging, sprinkle Abamectin Granular Fire Ant Bait uniformly in a circle around the base of the mound and out to a distance of approximately 2-4 ft. Be careful not to disturb the mound.

*0.4 oz. is approximately 1 tablespoon, 1.8 oz. is approximately 4 1/2 tablespoons

NOTE: Utensils used to measure pesticides should not be used for food purposes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage
