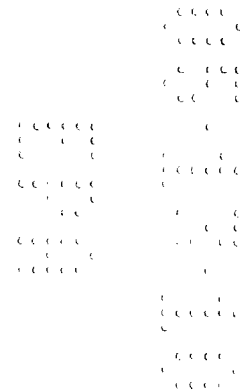

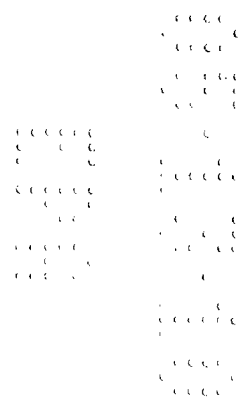

Only for repackaging to produce herbicide products for the following uses: corn, and grain and sorghum forage.

NOTE TO FORMULATORS

Formulators are responsible for obtaining EPA registration of their end-use product(s).

This product can only be used for repack purposes to produce products with **agricultural weed control directions** if the labeling for such end-use products contains a restricted use classification and certain required mixing/loading instructions and use directions to minimize the potential for surface and ground water contamination.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage

Ground water contamination may be reduced by diking and flooring of permanent liquid bulk storage sites with an impermeable material.
