- Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until dusts have settled.
- Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through drift.
- For use only on home lawns.

USE TIPS

- Use Azoxy 0.31/PPZ 0.75 Granular on home lawns to prevent disease before it appears or to control disease at the first sign of disease.
- For best results, begin applications prior to disease symptoms, when conditions are favorable for disease.
- Consult your local Cooperative Extension Service office or your state's land grant university for assistance with lawn disease identification and specific fungicide timing in your area to control lawn diseases.
- When used as directed, this product is safe to the lawn and controls the diseases listed.

How to Apply

- Water in the granules: Hose end or rainfall.
- Measure the length and width of area to be treated before application. Length X width = square feet. For example, an area 20 ft. wide and 25 ft. long is 500 sq. ft. [Insert optional graphic].
- Refer to the *Directions for Applications for Lawn Diseases* table for the rate to apply to control your lawn disease problem. Add the appropriate amount of Azoxy 0.31/PPZ 0.75 Granular to your granular spreader to cover your square footage of lawn. Refer to *Granular Spreader Settings* table for spreader settings to deliver the rate required.

- Uniform coverage is necessary to provide the most effective level of control.
- Azoxy 0.31/PPZ 0.75 Granular can be applied after seeding or at seed germination.
- Use the shorter retreatment intervals and higher application rates when prolonged favorable disease conditions exist.
- Do not apply more than 21.4 lbs. of Azoxy 0.31/PPZ 0.75 Granular per 1,000 sq. ft. in a single year.

Necrotic Ring Spot Pink Patch Red Thread Southern Blight Summer Patch	2 - 4	14 - 28	Apply when conditions are favorable for disease.
Leaf Spot Melting Out	2 - 4	14 - 21	Apply when conditions are favorable for disease.
Bentgrass Dead Spot	2 - 4	14	Begin applications prior to disease development.
Cool Weather Brown Patch Yellow Patch Rhizoctonia Large Patch	2 - 4	14 - 28	Make one or two applications in fall or when conditions are favorable for disease.
Fairy Ring	2 - 4	28	Apply as soon as possible after fairy ring symptoms develop. Severely damaged or thin turf may require reseeding. Fairy ring symptoms may take 2 to 3 weeks to disappear following application. Reapplication after 28 days may be required in some cases.

Take-All Patch	2 - 4	28	Apply twice in the fall (typically September and October) and twice in the spring (typically April and May). Treat southern lawns (warm season grasses such as bermudagrass and St. Augustinegrass) twice in the summer (June - August) as well.
Zoysia Patch	2 - 4	14 - 28	Make 1 to 2 applications, with the last application falling approximately one month prior to zoysiagrass dormancy.

SPREADER SETTINGS

(This paragraph - footnote to table of spreader settings) Spreader settings are approximate. Differences may occur due to condition of spreader, speed at which applied, and roughness of area treated. Be sure to check spreader at the beginning of the application, adjust spreader if necessary.

[Broadcast Spreaders: If your lawn is rectangular, apply two border strips across each end for a turning area. If your lawn is an irregular shape, apply a border strip completely around it. Then apply product back and forth in the longest direction. Turn the spreader off and on at the edge of each strip to prevent uneven application. Overlap the throw pattern by about a foot to ensure complete coverage.

Drop Spreaders: First apply two border strips along the edge of each end of the lawn. Then apply product along the length of lawn, overlapping slightly and shutting off the spreader before turning as you reach the edge of the border strips.]
