DIRECTIONS

Brulin's THORO KILL CONCENTRATE is designed for use in the Dyna-Fog* or other thermal aerosol fog machines. Use in accordance with equipment manufacturers' directions for operation on "dry fog" setting.

Application to be made by trained insecticide personnel only.

THIS IS A CONCENTRATE—DILUTE BEFORE USE

Dilute 1 part by volume with 6 parts light fuel oil, kerosene, petroleum distillate or equivalent. One gallon of diluted THORO KILL solution should cover approximately 1 acre. Fog slowly across the wind, with fog drifting away from operator. Best results are usually

obtained when fogging early in the morning, at sundown, or when wind velocity is low.
