A

FOR USE IN CLEANING AND DISINFECTING FLOORS, WALLS, WASHABLE FURNISHINGS AND FIXTURES.

For use on these surfaces in operating rooms and treatment facilities in hospitals, clinics, nursing centers and similar public and private institutions, and in industry. Will not diminish conductivity of conductive flooring.

Pseudomonicidal at dilution of 2 1/2 ounces per gallon (read complete directions below).

DISINFECTANT CLEANER #6 must be diluted before use. For general disinfection of floors, walls and fixtures, dilute 2 1/2 ounces of DISINFECTANT #6 in one gallon of warm water. Mop floors with new or freshly laundered wet mops set aside for this purpose only. Wear rubber or plastic gloves for hand scrubbing. Thoroughly scrub all surfaces.

(D)

DISINFECTANT CLEANER #6 solution should remain in contact with surfaces being disinfected for as long as possible. Treated surfaces used for food handling must be scrubbed with detergent and rinsed with potable water before re-use.

(E)

For areas suspected of severe contamination or high organic load, dilute 4 ounces of DISINFECTANT CLEANER #6 in one gallon of warm water. Proceed as above.

(F)

DISINFECTANT CLEANER #6 is effective against Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis and Pseudomonas aeruginosa. Mycobacterium tuberculosis and Trichophyton interdigitale.
