4. We noted a minor error in the label ingredient statement. Petroleum distillate should be 99.11% and inert ingredients 0.08%.

7. Add the statement:

Do not use in edible product areas of food processing
plants, restaurants or other areas where food is
commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in
serving areas while food is exposed.

8. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you
release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further
description of final printed labeling.

BROWN DOG TICKS. Spray infested areas around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of pets and localized areas of floors and floor coverings. Repeat as necessary. Bedding should be replaced in animal quarters after treatment. Do not treat animals with this product.
FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS. Outdoors: For use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches in garages and other places where these insects alight or congregate.
CHIGGERS, ANTS, BROWN DOG TICKS AND CLOVER MITES. Outdoors: For treatment of localized infestations of insects in outdoor areas where there is no vegetation used for food or feed, spray infested areas. For ants wet hills and runways. Repeat as necessary.
