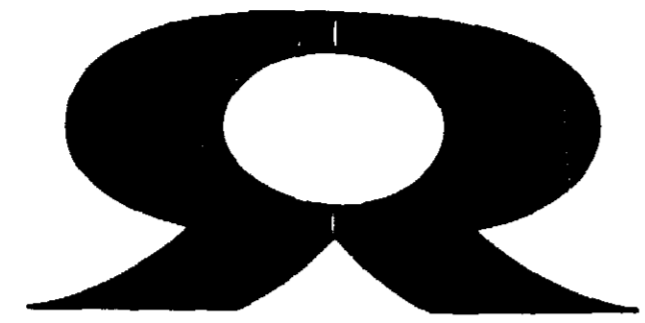

Fatal to flies, fleas, mosquitoes, gnats, moths, silverfish, ants, bed bugs, carpet beetles, chicken mites, spiders, wasps and hornets when reached by the spray.

Useful in the home, dairy barns, milk rooms, stables, poultry houses, hog barns, grocery and butcher shops, factories, fur stores etc.

Food Processing Plants: Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when plant is not in operation.

Warning and Caution

Caution: This solution if brought into contact with skin can cause toxic symptoms. Avoid inhalation and skin contact. In case of spillage on the skin wash with soap and water. In the house. Close doors and windows. Spray toward ceiling and windows until the room is filled with fine mist. Keep room closed for 10 minutes. Sweep up and burn dead insects.

In the cattle barn. Spray into the air above the cattle or other animals. Do not spray directly at or on them. Be sure the sprayer or fogger is throwing a fine mist. Best results can be secured when the doors and windows are closed. Keep premises clean. Spray about 15 minutes before milking.

Hog and Hen Houses. To kill flies and gnats, spray toward ceiling and upper side walls, fill the air, keep house closed for 10 minutes.

DIRECTIONS

- Repeat as often as necessary.
- Flies, Gnats and Mosquitoes in House.** Close doors and windows. Spray toward windows and ceiling until the room is filled with fine mist. Keep room closed for 10 minutes. Sweep up and burn dead insects.
- Silverfish and Spiders.** Spray toward ceiling and windows until the room is filled with fine mist. Spray also on floors and wherever they are found. Spray on the spot.
- Wasps and Hornets.** Spray directly at nest or on the insects as they inhabit.
- Bed Bugs.** Take the bed apart. Spray under mattress, under floorboards, under floor, under loose wall paper and under baseboards.
- Fleas in Houses and Basements.** Spray into the air above the animal coverings and sidewalls. Also spray the animal coverings, bedding, and windows for fifteen minutes.
- Clothes Moths and Carpet Beetles.** Spray into the air above the entire surface of rugs, furs and wall-to-wall carpeting. Also spray the seams and folds of fur and wool. Repeat the treatment every 3 or 4 weeks.
- Ants.** Locate their entrance and spray directly into it. Repeat the treatment in the nest. Repeat as needed.
- Chicken Mites.** Spray roosts, feed troughs, and other places where they inhabit.

Kills Flies and Mosquitoes

Use in garbage cans, cesspools, manure pits, hog barns, shelter sheds, unsanitary litter, and other places where mosquitoes and flies gather. Repeat as often as needed.

Autos. Spray into car with windows closed. Repeat as needed.
