ON CLOTHING—Spray shirts, stockings, hats, etc. For chiggers, ticks and fleas, spray pants cuffs, socks, tops of shoes and around openings in outer clothing. Does not damage nylon, orlon, cotton and wool. Do not use on acetate, rayon and dyne!

ON SCREENS—When sprayed on screens to discourage entrance of mosquitoes and gnats, direct spray at an angle. Do not spray through screen openings.

Do not puncture or throw container into fire nor place on stove or where temperature will exceed 120° F. which may cause it to burst. May damage some plastic, painted or varnished surfaces.
