Madison Spray Insecticide is recommended for the control of insects in institutions, warehouses, food processing plants, meat packers, dairy plants, bakeries, bottling plants, public buildings, industrial plants and similar buildings. It is effective against a broad spectrum of flying insects such as gnats, flies, wasps, hornets, grain moths, mosquitoes, and crawling insects including roaches, ants, crickets, spiders, waterbugs, silverfish, bedbugs, carpet beetles and ticks.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USING

Flying Insects - For control of flies, mosquitoes, gnats, wasps and similar flying insects, direct the spray toward the upper part of the room and saturate the atmosphere using 1 oz. per 1000 cu. ft. of space. Whenever possible, close off the infested area. Keep area closed for 10 minutes after spraying. Use the product as a space spray in food processing plants only when plant is not in operation. Food should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered or thoroughly cleaned before using. Whenever possible, sweep up or destroy fallen insects after the treatment period.

Crawling Insects - For control of roaches, waterbugs, silverfish and crickets, spray infested areas thoroughly and make an attempt to hit the insects directly. Direct spray into cracks, crevices, recesses and hiding places such as behind baseboards, moldings, ceiling, door and window frames, pipes, draught and door corners. Repeat spraying often as necessary for complete control. Control is similar for roaches. For ants, spray along ant trails and at entry points. This is important.

For control of stored product insects, spray areas that become infested with insects such as mealworms, sawflies, weevils, moths, grain and cheese mites and other insects. Spray all contaminated foods and surfaces including shelves, bins, boxes, and other similar storage areas. Give particular attention to cracks, crevices and other hiding places. Repeat application as required.

Do not use in areas where heat is present. Do not use near heat of open flame.
