

DO NOT USE DETERGENT SANITIZER on recommended for use on food processing equipment and utensils including dair and brewery equipment and utensils. It is also recommended for use on dishes and glasses.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Prepare a sanitizing solution by dissolving 4 1/2 or 8 1/2 oz. DART 860 DETERGENT SANITIZER per 10 gallons of water. This provides a solution containing 100 ppm or 200 ppm of available chlorine respectively. Clean and rinse items prior to sanitizing. Then place glasses, dishes, equipment or utensils in solution for 2-5 minutes. Remove, rinse with potable water and dry. For flat surfaces, clean to remove gross filth and heavy soil. Then spread the sanitizing solution and allow to stand 2-5 minutes and then rinse with potable water. The same solution may be used in feed tank in immersion or spray type machines providing 2-5 minutes contact time for sanitizing dishes, glasses, food processing equipment and utensils. Clean and rinse items prior to sanitizing. After sanitizing step rinse well with potable water and dry. The items are then ready for use. The sanitizing solution should be used promptly after mixing. If the solution is allowed to stand or is reused and tests show the level of chlorine has not been maintained, additional DART 860 DETERGENT SANITIZER should be added to maintain a minimum concentration of 100 ppm available chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep product dry in tightly closed containers when not in use. Store in a cool well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of a decomposition isolate container if possible and flood with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding. Place in trash collection or dispose in approved landfill area or bury in a safe place.
