- DIRECTIONS -

INSECTS CONTROLLED: Resistant spider mites (red spider) aphids, whitefly and some species of mealy bugs, thrips, and soft brown scale on ornamental plants in greenhouses. TEDION is slow acting, allow seven days for optimum results.

CAUTION: Avoid all inhalation of smoke or fumes. May cause leaf drop on some species of roses (White Butterfly). Use with caution on roses during short light days i.e., October to May, leaf drop may occur. At time when flowers are in open bloom, ventilate greenhouse two and one-half hours after fumigation.

TEMPERATURE CONTROL: Greenhouses should be tightly closed and maintained at not less than 65 during fumigation. The walks should be wet down just before fumigation to help hold the fumes close to the plants; the resultant condensation will help to seal-up the cracks. Do not wet the plants before fumigation. A quiet day should be selected for fumigation as windy weather causes leakage and "drift" of the fumes.

SYMPTOMS OF POISONING: Pupils of eyes or eye shrink to "pinpoint" size. A sense of tightness in chest. Stomach pains. Vomiting and diarrhea. Headache.

ANTIDOTE-INTERNAL: Give a tablespoonful of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have victim lie down and keep warm and quiet. Call a physician immediately.

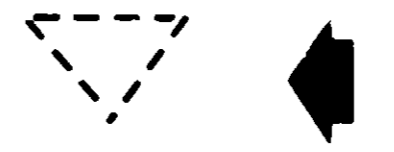

- PROCEDURE -

1. Shake can vigorously to fluff up or loosen the powder. Puncture both triangular marks as indicated on top side of can, using tool furnished. If vertical evolution of smoke is preferred, puncture can on top lid instead of sides. Place cans on walks, spaced to furnish equal distribution of fumes. If walks are very wet or are wooden, set cans up on empty flower pots.

2. Light one of enclosed igniters, tilt can sharply backwards to throw powder away from one of punctured openings. Insert burning lighter entirely inside the can through opening and tilt can forward to level powder. Prompt ignition results. Place can on floor with the punctured holes pointed lengthwise of the walk. Proceed quickly to the next can and continue until all cans are ignited.

3. For best results, store cans at room temperature because warm material burns more evenly.

WARNING: Avoid skin or eye contact with powder. Avoid inhalation of dust. Wear a mask or respirator of a type passed by the U.S. Department of Agriculture for protection against pyrophosphorous pentoxide. Avoid contact with clothing. Do not use in greenhouses containing flammable materials.

ANTIDOTE: Call a Physician immediately! Give a tablespoonful of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have victim lie down and keep warm. Give strong tea or coffee. Give artificial respiration if breathing has stopped.

DANGER: Rapidly absorbed through skin and eyes. Poisonous if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin or eyes. Avoid skin or eye contact with can. Avoid inhalation of dithio dust. Use a mask or respirator of a type passed by the U.S. department of Agriculture for protection against pyrophos nite. Wear natural rubber gloves. Protective clothing and goggles. Keep all unprotected persons out of operational area or vicinity where there may be danger until greenhouses have been thoroughly aired.
