  - b. Change "Avoid over-application of this product." to: "Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Heavy application and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness; if biting insects do not respond to a thin film of repellent, apply a bit more."
  - c. Change "After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water." to:

    "After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water or bathe. This is
    particularly important when repellents are used repeatedly in a day or on
    consecutive days."

2. The Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines for repellent products. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for personal repellent products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.
