Apply on face by first spraying small amounts in palm of hand and spreading on face and neck. Prevent children from rubbing eyes if hands are treated with spray. To repel chiggers, ticks and fleas, spray pant cuffs, socks and around openings in outer clothing. For maximum protection on skin, spread by hand after application. Will not damage nylon, cotton or wool. May damage some synthetic fabrics, plastics, leather, painted or varnished surfaces.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.
