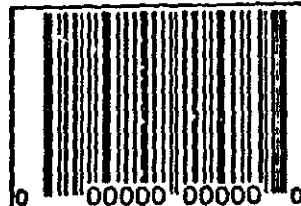
USE ONLY AS A SPOT SPRAY. DO NOT USE AS A SPACE SPRAY. Shake well before using. Hold can about two feet from surface to be sprayed. Spray with a slow sweeping action to localized areas in carpeting, rugs, drapes and upholstered surfaces of furniture. Be sure to treat pet's bedding as fleas abound here. DO NOT USE in food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. DO NOT USE in serving areas while food is exposed. REMOVE pets and tightly COVER or remove fish bowls and aquariums. DO NOT TREAT PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT. Treat pets with a product registered for animal application to control the source of flea and tick infestation.

BEFORE USING near appliances with pilot lights, be sure to extinguish pilot lights. TURN OFF electrical equipment in area being treated. DO NOT smoke while using.

Keep children and pets off treated surfaces until dry. Remove and destroy treated pet's bedding. Replace bedding with clean or new material.

KILLS FLEAS: Also kills roaches, crickets, ticks, spiders, ants, flies and other household insects.
