- a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 121-45."
- b. Submit a 1 year storage stability study. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredient at time zero and during a year in storage. The storage must be under warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity using containers similar to those that will be used in the trade. This data must be submitted within 12 months of the date of this registration notice.
- c. Verify the third source of your active ingredient. Our records show that EPA Reg. No. 1167-102 was transferred to 54262-75 and then cancelled.

Cutter Tick Repellent also repels fleas, mosquitoes, gnats, chiggers and biting flies.

For added protection from ticks, wear shoes or boots, tuck pants into socks. Wear long sleeved shirt tucked into pants, inspect often for ticks. Do not apply on skin under clothing. Wash treated skin after returning indoors and double-check yourself, other family members and pets for ticks.

Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary. Apply on face by first spraying small amounts in palm of hand and spreading on face and neck. Do not apply to the hands of young children. For extra protection from crawling ticks, chiggers and fleas, use extra spray along all openings of clothing, such as neck band, waist band, pant and sleeve cuffs, sock tops and other areas where these insects may crawl under clothing. Will not damage cotton, denim, wool, nylon or Orlon. Do not apply on or near synthetic fabrics such as Rayon, Spandex or Dynel, leather, plastic watch crystals and painted or varnished surfaces.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container, and discard in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate.
