The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- 1) Products 121-18, 121-25, 121-30, and 121-34 need the statement "Wash treated clothing". None of these products indicate that the product should not be applied to clothing and there is a strong possibility the product can be absorbed by clothing near areas of application (sleeves, collars or cuffs).
- 2) Product 121-29 needs the statement "Do not spray in enclosed areas".
- 3) For products 121-31, 121-33, and 121-45, remove the statement "Contains no ~~OP~~'s".

PHYSICAL/CHEMICAL HAZARDS: EXTREMELY FLAMMABLE. Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near fire, sparks, or heated surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:
