2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase, "EPA Registration No. 121-50".
- b. Add at the beginning of Directions for Use "Read all directions before using this product".
- c. Add the following statements to the Directions for Use:  
Do not spray in enclosed areas. Do not apply over wounds or irritated skin. Use just enough repellent to

cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid overexposure. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you.

- d. Add to the precautionary statement under hazard to humans the phrase "Do not smoke during application".
- e. Remove "DEET" from the ingredient statement. It is not an accepted common name. It may appear elsewhere on the label.
- f. Delete the phrase "provides hours of protection for the whole family". We object to this phrase as a safety claim.

3. You cited 3 acute studies from the DEET Registration Standard in support of this application. In the future, please identify those studies by the MRID numbers to simplify our review.

4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Will not damage nylon, cotton, wool. May damage some synthetic fabrics, plastic watch crystals, leather, painted and varnished surfaces.
