On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g)(2)(c) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

Based on your response to the Reregistration Eligibility Document(s), EPA has reregistered the product listed above provided that the following change is made to the label:

- 1. In accordance with PR Notice 2001-3:
 - a. Change the following statement "Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin." to: "Never use repellents over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin."
 - b. Change the following statement "Avoid over-application of this product." to: "Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Heavy application and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness; if biting insects do not respond to a thin film of repellent, apply a bit more."
 - c. Change the following statements: "After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again." to" After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water or bathe. This is particularly important when repellents are used repeatedly in a day or on consecutive days. Also, wash treated clothing before wearing it again."
- 2. Within the First Aid Section, the "If you suspect a reaction to this product: Discontinue use. Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for

15 to 20 minutes. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advise." may be removed, since it is redundant to text already contained within the Directions for Use. The insertion of this text is not required under PR Notice 2001-1.

3. The Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines for repellent products. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for personal repellent products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.

Do not use in enclosed areas. To apply, put a small amount in palm of hand, rub palms together, then spread evenly over exposed skin. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. When using on face. apply sparingly, avoiding eyes. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears. Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Do not apply to sunburned skin. Do not apply to children's hands. Do not allow children to handle this product. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child. [For extra protection from (crawling) ticks, chiggers and fleas, apply along all openings of clothing, such as neckband, waistband, pant and sleeve cuffs, sock lops and other areas where insects may crawl under clothing.
