On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g)(2)(c) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

Based on your response to the Reregistration Eligibility Document(s), EPA has reregistered the product listed above provided that the following change is made to the label:

- 1. Remove the following marketing claims:
  - a. [NOW... PLEASANT PROTECTION THA TS EFFECTIVE FOR HOURS!
- 2. Revise the Net Weight from Total Net Wt 3 oz (85g) to fluid ounces and mg. 1
- 3. Within the Directions for Use section, revise as follows:
  - a. Directly below the FIFRA required statement "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling" Replace all text with following statements:

<sup>1</sup> Liquid Formulations. The net contents must be expressed as gallons, quarts, pints or fluid ounces [See 40 CFR 156.10(d)]

"For Outdoor Use Only. Never use repellents over cuts, wounds, sunburned or irritated skin. Do not apply near eyes and mouth, and apply sparingly around ears. Do not allow children to handle this product, and do not apply to children's hands. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child. Apply only to exposed skin and/or clothing (as directed on the product label). Do not use under clothing. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin. Heavy application and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness; if biting insects do not respond to a thin film of repellent, apply a bit more. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water or bathe. This is particularly important when repellents are used repeatedly in a day or on consecutive days. Also, wash treated clothing before wearing it again. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect a reaction to this product, discontinue use, wash treated skin, and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this product with you.

Remove the lid from the container by pulling upward. Remove the protective foil. Lift flap on lid. Pull up the center towelette and thread the corner of towelette through the open flap in lid; DO NOT push finger through lid opening. Replace lid on container. Towelettes should be pulled at an angle to dispense one at a time. The lid should be tightly closed on container between uses to keep towelettes from drying out. [Optional directions for a single packet towelette: Tear open foil pack.] Unfold towelette and wipe evenly over exposed skin.

4. Revise the Storage and Disposal Section as follows:

"Storage and Disposal

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool dry place away from heat or open flame. Pesticide Disposal: If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions."

- 5. Remove the following subsection and associated text from the First Aid section:<sup>2</sup>
  "IF YOU SUSPECT A REACTION TO THIS PRODUCT: Discontinue use.
  Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice. 20 minutes"
- 6. The Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines for repellent products. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for personal repellent products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.

7. Note: The Notification approval dated February 24, 2006 by the Agency is rescinded. The 8570-1 form indicates that the submission was for 121-56 in Box 1, but the product name, and label are for 121-88.
