Please find enclosed our notification per PR Notice 97-5 to modify the ingredient statement to substitute the common name DEET for the chemical name n, n-Diethyl-m-toluamide. We are also adding the claim "CONTAINS DEET [n, n-Diethyl-m-toluamide] as outlined in the EPA letter dated September 27, 2002.

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 97-5 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 97-5 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.
